

Google Maps Requirements for Website Use

Google Maps billing changes and what you need to do to keep maps working on your website.

Why the Changes

New pricing changes will go into effect starting July 16, 2018. For more information, check out the Guide for Existing Users.

The good news is the process is easy, and in most cases, you will not be charged because the included monthly credit will cover the needs of your website traffic. High traffic sites (greater than 28k monthly views of pages containing a map) will be charged \$7/thousand map views by Google.

In order to keep Google Maps working on your website, you must complete the following steps.

- 1. Select or create Google (Gmail) Account to use
- 2. Enter billing info
- 3. Configure APIs
- 4. Submit to Bluetent

Step 1. Select or Create a Account

Use a Google Account connected to an email you actively check.

1. GA account email

2. Rezfusion Cloud and Essential users

If you currently use a Cloud or Essential websites from Bluetent, you can log into the Gmail account you created for the website launch. The format of the account would be: yourcompany.bluetent@gmail.com

Step 2. Enter billing information into Google Cloud Platform

- 1. Sign into your Gmail account
- 2. Go to: cloud.google.com/maps-platform
- 3. Add billing info
- 4. Activate APIs
- 5. Done

Step 3. Configure APIs (2)

It sounds complicated, but it is actually simple to get the APIs required for Google Map use on your website.

- 1. Sign into your Gmail account
- 2. Go to: https://console.cloud.google.com
- 3. Following API Instructions <u>here</u>.

Step 3. Continued - Javascript API Key

- 1. Select Details on Javascript API
- 2. Select Credentials Tab
- 3. Select Create Credentials
 - i. Name Javascript API
 - 1. Restrict/Secure API
 - 2. Select HTTP referrers (this means you are going to use urls to control security
 - 3. For Websites: Enter two domains (Cloud and Essential users can skip this step) yourwebsitedomain.com dev.rescmshost.com
 - 4. SAVE

Step 3. Continued - GeoCoding API Key

- 1. Enable Geocoding API form inactive list of APIs
- 2. Select Credentials Tab
- 3. Select Create Credentials
 - i. Name Geocoding API
 - 1. No restriction or security required
 - 2. SAVE

Step 4. Submit API Keys to Bluetent
